Layer description

Definition: The indicator evaluates future developments which could have consequences for ecological connectivity (negative as well as positive consequences).

Realization: The indicator is based on communal land use plans. Their elements represent mostly the negative consequences whereas the positive consequences are represented by local nature conservation areas.

Classification: The different planning measures were classified by expert opinions.
